

Indonesia Higher Education

Indonesia in 2010 had 82 public universities and 2,876 private universities within 373 districts across the nation's 33 provinces.

Public universities are under the Ministry of Education & Culture's Department of Higher Education. Private universities supervision is handled by Koordinator Perguruan Tinggi Swasta (Kopertis). Islamic Studies Institutions are supervised by the Ministry of Religion.

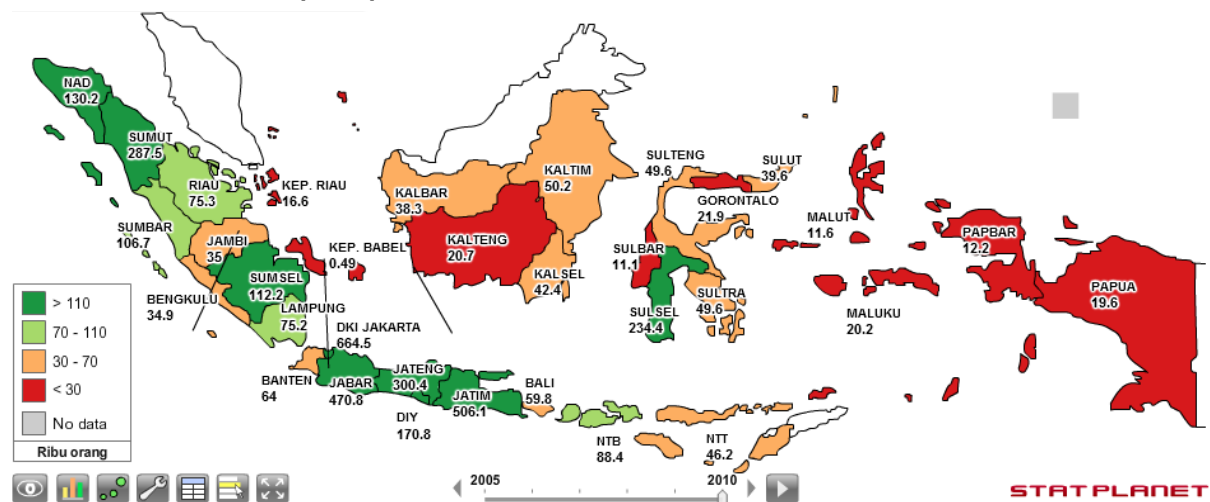
